The *Privacy Act 1988* (and subsequent amendments) covers most private sector organisations, including all health service providers in Australia. This Act makes provision to protect the privacy of individuals.

Uses and disclosures of personal information include...

- Disclosure of information to other medical practitioners, hospitals or health service providers to assist in any current or future treatments that relate to the condition you are currently being treated for.
- Use of information to train and educate professional staff.
- We must also comply with laws that require us to collect or disclose information about you.
- Use and/or disclosure of Information required for management or statistical purposes (eg Cancer Registry of Australia or your private health fund).
